Clinical social workers have a special awareness of the psychological, social, economic and cultural factors that affect people's well being.

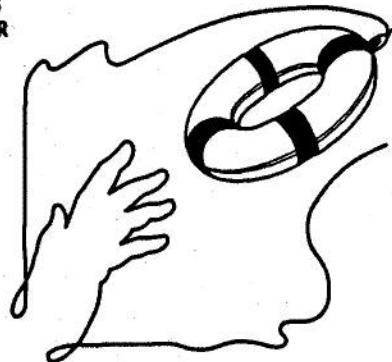

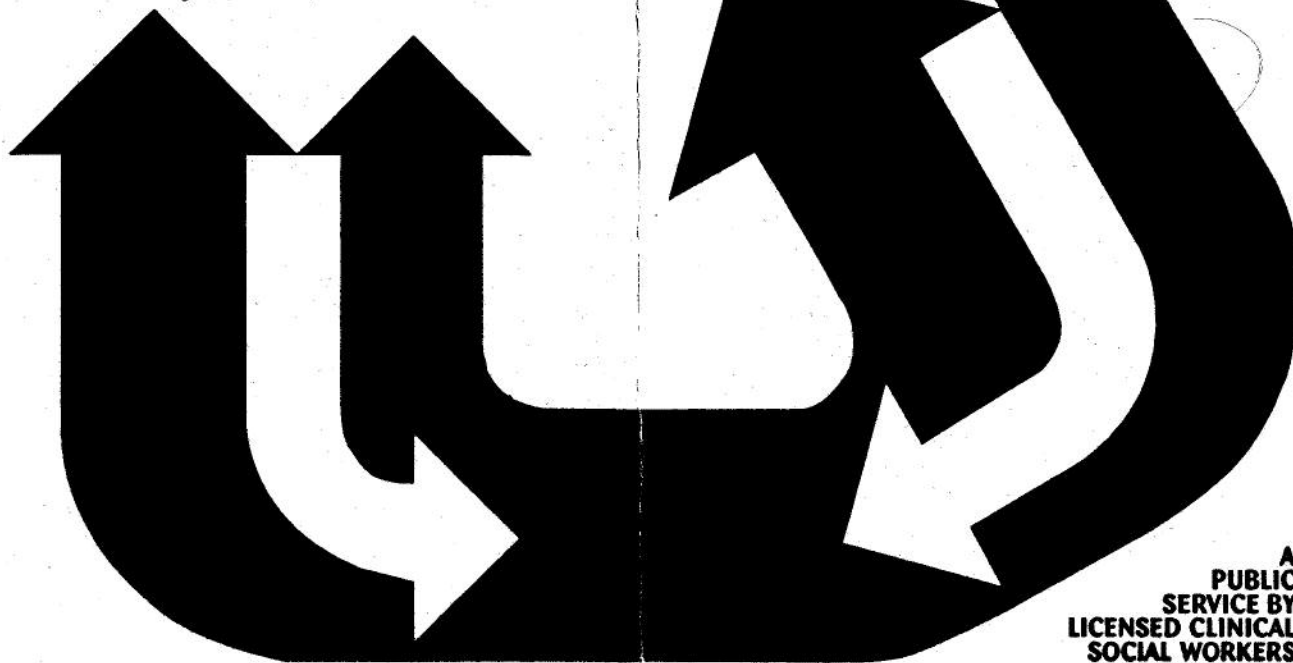

HELP FOR SPECIAL NEEDS



Specialists are available for:

- Relationship Counseling—Communication; infidelity; trust; mutual activities
- Anger Management—Dysfunctional family; domestic violence
- Depression and Anxiety—Panic attacks; agoraphobia; chronic fatigue; emotional problems; suicidal tendencies
- Stress Reduction and Hypnosis—Building morale and self-confidence; help break undesirable habits; control phobias
- Divorce and Step-Family Problems—Anger, depression, resentment; conflict of authority parenting skills; starting over
- Managing Children's Behavior Problems—Divorce; inappropriate behavior; step-family problems; learning disabilities; attention deficit disorders
- Adult and Child Abuse—Physical, emotional, verbal, sexual abuse; past or present molestation; dysfunctional family
- Addictive Behavior—Alcohol, gambling, drugs; compulsive over-eating, anorexia and bulimia



- Women's Issues—Sexual attitudes and problems; infertility; lack of personal fulfillment; rape; spousal abuse; co-dependency; loneliness; empty nest



- Men's Issues—Business and family roles; mid-life crisis; retirement
